
Rolling for Number Lines

You will need: ruler, die, and paper, journal or whiteboard

1. Use a ruler to draw 5 six-inch number lines. Each number line should begin at 0 and end at 1.



- 2. Roll a die and divide your number line into that many equal parts.
 - If you roll 1 I you can roll again
 - If you roll 5 ⊡, you lose a turn



- 3. Draw a point and label each part of the number line with a fraction. Explain your reasoning.
- 4. Repeat until you have divided all 5 number lines .
